Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Disposed of pursuant to merger agreement among issuer, RWE Aktiengesellschaft (RWE), Thames Water Aqua Holdings GmbH (Thames) and Apollo whereby each share of issuer common stock issued and outstanding was converted into the right to receive \$46 per share on the effective date of merger (January 3, 2002).
- (2) These phantom shares were disposed of under the Reporting Person's deferred stock account in accordance with the merger agreement among issuer, RWE Aktiengesellschaft (RWE), Thames Water Aqua Holdings GmbH (Thames) and Apollo (see footnote 1 above).
- (3) This option, which provided for vesting in three equal installments beginning May 4, 2001, was canceled in the merger in exchange for a cash payment equal to the exercise price of the option and the merger consideration (\$46 per share).
- (4) This option, which provided for vesting in three equal installments beginning January 3, 2002, was canceled in the merger in exchange for a cash payment equal to the exercise price of the option and the merger consideration (\$46 per share).

Know all by these presents, that the undersigned hereby constitutes and appoints W. Timothy Pohl, George Patrick, Taara Young, and Margaret Tracy signing singly, the undersigned's attorney-in-fact to:
